### HAVE YOU CONSIDERED WHERE YOU WILL SERVE?

Listed below are some areas we need additional workers at this time. If everyone served in at least one area, it would only require serving twice a year. Since everyone won't participate, you may be needed approximately four times a year. A monthly schedule will be put in your mailbox during the previous month. If the date you are assigned does not work for you, you are encouraged to trade with someone on a date that does work. Others are usually willing to trade, so this is not difficult. Please consider receiving and being a blessing by serving in one or more of these areas:

**Greeters/Bulletin distributors:** Arrive 20 minutes before the worship service to give a smile and a hello at the outside doors and help make our church a welcoming place or hand out bulletins at the sanctuary doors. (This works great for individuals and families.)

**Ushers:** Arrive 20 minutes before the worship service to help those attending each service find a place to sit, collect the offering and serve the congregation to make them comfortable and welcome.

**Nursery Volunteer:** Care for infants and toddlers in the nursery during 8:30 service, Sunday School time, 11:00 service and special meetings. May be male or female at least middle school age to volunteer.

**Server for Fellowship Time:** Arrive at 9:00 to prepare and serve coffee and juice between 8:30 service and Sunday School. North Oak provides all the supplies and instructions. (Can also be prepared before 8:30 service if that's when you attend.)
