VBS UPDATE: Our VBS is history and we can report a very successful week. Attendance was great with an average of 93 students per day and 100 attending on Wednesday and 99 on Tuesday. The children and staff collected \$1,058.13 during the week and people at the program added \$188.75, giving a total of \$1,246.88 for our mission project. (This will provide at least 25 water filters to be taken to the Dominican Republic.) We know of four girls accepting Jesus as their Savior. PTL! We express a big thank you to the Travis Keller Family and the drama participants for decorating the Sanctuary and Gathering Space for the Rainforest there. Teachers added wonderful decorations for their classrooms. A big thanks to the classroom teachers, helpers, the center directors and all of the staff for a tremendous job.
