fight for meeting space, since nothing would be happening. Who are these
volunteers - the people without whom we could not function? They are you
and me...God's people responding with a strong commitment to live out our
faith in this world. **Be a volunteer! It takes approximately 60 volunteers**
each Sunday! What would God have you do? Where could you help?
