The Hays Rotary Club is organizing its first **Paint-A-Thon** partnering with Hays area churches through the Ellis County Ministerial Alliance and FHSU Tigers in Service. This unique community partnership is designed to paint the outside of homes owned and occupied by persons with limited financial resources who are at least 60 years of age or have a permanent disability making them unable to do the work themselves. Homeowners selected will have their homes painted at no cost. Volunteers will paint the outside of selected homes on **September 24. Teams and individual members are needed** to serve as volunteer painters, team leaders and coordinators. At least 20–30 volunteers are needed at each location to help paint the house, provide food and beverages, help with set-up and cleaning, preparing the house for painting, and other tasks. Individuals will be encouraged to bring their own brushes, scrapers, putty knives, rags and ladders if they have them. Let’s make some “NOCC Teams” to serve our community by joining in the painting!!
