GET TO THE HEART OF CHANGE IN YOUR LIFE

James 3:13-16 (Pew Bible page 855)

Change doesn't come as a result of "resolutions." Change comes as a result of the grace of God working in our lives as we appropriate the truth of Christ's work on the cross!

1. Real life-change requires something different than what many suggest. (13a)
2. You know you are following false wisdom when your core desires and motivations are self centered. (13b-14)
3. False wisdom can only see life from the limited viewpoint of this world or worse. (15)
4. False wisdom ultimately causes confusion and evil behavior. (16)
