### **Adult Sunday School for the Summer...will meet in the auditorium**

*This summer we plan to view & discuss a video series by Ray Vander Laan. These videos are filmed "on location" in Bible locations tied with insight Scripture and life lessons. We'll begin this great study **June 6.***
