## Prophet *and* a King

### 1) The Proud (2 Kings 18): Sennacherib

This chapter recounts an event in which King Sennacherib sends an army to capture Jerusalem, but first they begin with taunts and insults.

**NIV 2 Kings 18:32-35** *“Choose life and not death! Do not listen to Hezekiah, for he is misleading you when he says, ‘The LORD will deliver us.’<sup>33</sup>Has the god of any nation ever delivered his land from the hand of the king of Assyria?...Who of all the gods of these countries has been able to save his land from me? **How then can the LORD deliver Jerusalem from my hand?**”*

### 2) The Humble (2 Kings 19:1-19): Hezekiah

Hezekiah, the king of Jerusalem, doesn't respond to these taunts and insults, instead he seeks the Lord.

**NIV 2 Kings 19:1** *<sup>1</sup>When King Hezekiah heard this, he tore his clothes and put on sackcloth and went into the temple of the LORD.*

**NIV 2 Kings 19:14-16** *<sup>14</sup>Hezekiah received the letter...Then he went up to the temple of the LORD and **spread it out before the LORD.***

<sup>15</sup>And **Hezekiah prayed** to the LORD: *“LORD...you alone are God over all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made heaven and earth.*

<sup>16</sup>**Give ear, LORD, and hear; **open your eyes, LORD, and see;** listen to the words Sennacherib has sent to ridicule the living God.**

### 3) The Glorious: God (2 Kings 19:20-37)

This event ends with an incredible work of God—He rescues His people and glorifies His name.

**NIV 2 Kings 19:20-21** *<sup>20</sup>Then Isaiah...sent a message to Hezekiah: “This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: I have **heard your prayer** concerning Sennacherib king of Assyria. <sup>21</sup>This is the word that **the LORD has spoken against him**:...Because you rage against me and because your insolence has reached my ears, **I will** put my hook in your nose and my bit in your mouth, and **I will** make you return by the way you came.’*

**NIV 2 Kings 19:34** *<sup>34</sup>“I will defend this city and save it, **for my sake** and for the sake of David my servant.’ ”*

**NIV 2 Kings 19:35-36** *<sup>35</sup>That night **the angel of the LORD** went out and put to death a hundred and eighty-five thousand in the Assyrian camp. When the people got up the next morning—there were all the dead bodies! <sup>36</sup>So Sennacherib king of Assyria broke camp and withdrew. He returned to Nineveh and stayed there.*

### Taking it home

God honors those who honor him (1 Samuel 2:30; Luke 12:8-10).

Give Him glory and praise! (Psalm 27) He humbled himself and took up our wrongs so that we can be saved! (Isaiah 49; Isaiah 53)

**NIV Isaiah 49:13** *<sup>13</sup>Shout for joy, you heavens; rejoice, you earth; burst into song, you mountains! For the LORD comforts his people and will have compassion on his afflicted ones.*

- 1) Consider the power of God. Humble yourself before Him. Recognize His strength and honor Him. God is honored through your Hezekiah's humility. How does humility sync with your heart? Ask the Holy Spirit about this.
